

## Bootstrap File Listing

The File Listing extension generates a listing of the contents of a specified directory on your web site. For example, if you have a directory on your web site with PDF files then this extension will automatically scan this folder and display the contents on your web page as links, so users can download these files.

### Key Features

- Display a list of the files in a directory on the server.
- Only display specific file types.
- Bootstrap look and feel.
- Built-in search field to filter files.
- Pagination (number of items per page)
- Column sorting
- Striped and hover rows colors.
- Many other styling options.

Note that you must publish the page to view the results. WYSIWYG Web Builder will only display a place holder for the viewer.

### Folder to scan

Specifies the folder on the web server to scan for the specified file types.

Use `./` to scan the current folder.

Notes:

- The folder name should end with "/"!
- Make sure the folder exists on the web server!
- You can use this extension in combination with the File Publisher object of WYSIWYG Web Builder, so the File Publisher will take care of uploading the files to your web site.

### File types

File types to show. Use a comma to separate multiple files types.

For example: ***jpg, mp3, pdf***

### Date format

Specifies the format of the date format (PHP format).

### Link Target

Link target controls where the file will be displayed when the user follows a link. Most of the time, clicking on a link simply loads in the same window where the link was. However, with Link Target, you can have the new document open in a new window, or if you are using frames, in another frame.

Examples:

**\_blank**: opens the link in a new window

**\_self**: open the link in the current frame

**\_parent**: open the link in the parent frame

**\_top**: loads the linked document in the topmost frame

## Text

In the text section you can customize the text labels.

## Pagination Properties

With pagination you can specify how many items will be displayed per page.

Two types of pagination are supported:

- **Bootstrap**, this will display all page numbers with 'Next' and 'Previous' buttons.
- **Page X of X**, this will display for example: **Page 1 of 5**

## Appearance Properties

This extension has many styling options, most of these options are self explainable and otherwise just try them out to see what effect they have on the output.

### ***How to install this extension so it is available in WYSIWYG Web Builder?***

You can use the Extension Manager (Menu->Tools->Extension Manager) to install this extension.

Alternatively, you can manually copy all files from the zip file to the Web Builder extensions folder. Usually this folder is in this location:

My Documents\WYSIWYG Web Builder\system\extensions\
