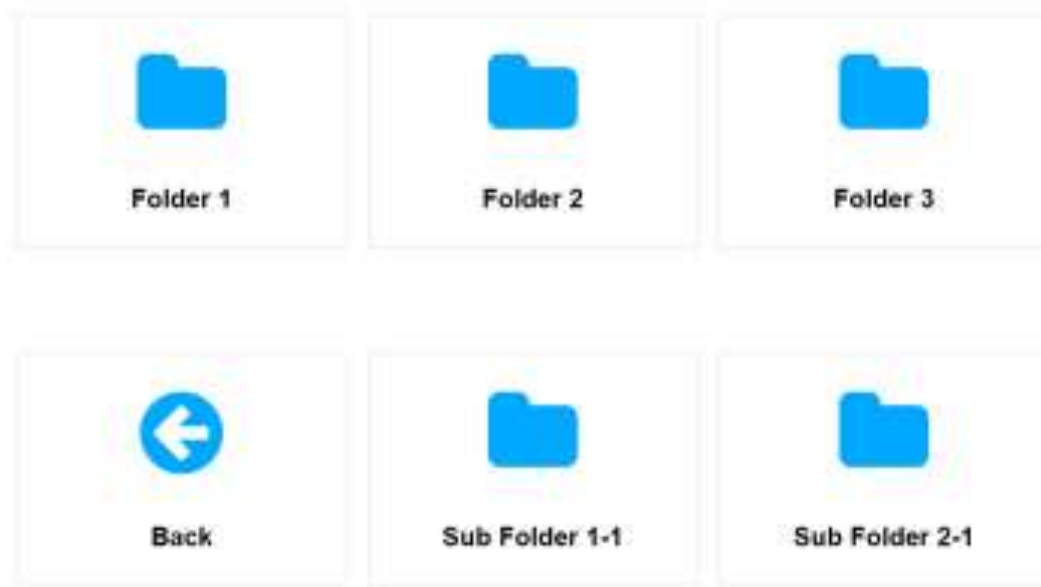


Folder Menu

This extension implements a responsive multi-level menu that displays a list of links in a folder-like format, inspired by the look of the Windows file explorer. Clicking one of the icons will go into the next level. The 'Back' button can be used to go back to the previous level. The extension has lots of options to customize the appearance of the menu.



General Properties

You will use the General page of the properties to add, edit and remove menu items to the menu.

Select **Add** to insert a new item to the menu. You can set the following properties:

- **Text**
Specifies the text of the folder or link.
- **Link to**
Specifies the type of link: Website, Internal Page or None.
Use **Website** to link to a page in an external website.
Use **Internal Page** to link to a page within the current website.
Use **None** to create a folder that will be the parent for other links. This item will get a '+'/'-' icon in front of it.
- **URL**
Specifies the URL (Internet Address) of the item.
- **Target**
Enter the window to which the link is targeted. For example: _blank (opens the link in a new window).

Select **Edit** to modify the properties of an existing item.

To remove an item from the menu click **Delete**.

Move Up

Move the selected item up amongst its siblings.

Move Down

Move the selected item down amongst its siblings.

Move Left

Make the selected item a sibling of its parent.

Move Right

Make the selected item the child of its preceding sibling.

To rearrange the items in the menu you can also use drag and drop to move the items around.

Style Properties

Set style properties, like font family, size, colors, padding, icons etc.

Responsive Properties

The font-size, padding, margin, icon size and number of columns are responsive, which means that they can have a different value in breakpoints.

How to install this extension so it is available in WYSIWYG Web Builder?

You can use the Extension Manager (Menu->Tools->Extension Manager) to install this extension.

Alternatively, you can manually copy all files from the zip file to the Web Builder extensions folder. Usually this folder is in this location:

My Documents\WYSIWYG Web Builder\system\extensions\
