

Fullscreen Slideshow Extension

This extension implements a responsive full screen slideshow with navigation thumbnails. It is possible to add a pattern overlay, so the slideshow can be used as a 'dimmed' background. And an (optional) title can be set for each image.

Transition Duration

Specifies the duration of the transition

Interval

Specifies the interval between images. Set the interval to '0' to disable automatic navigation.

Enabled pattern

Specifies whether to use a pattern overlay.

Thumbnails Size

Specifies the size of the navigation thumbnails. Use '0' to hide the thumbnails.

Thumbnails Offset

Specifies the thumbnail offset (from the bottom).

Thumbnails Spacing

Specifies the spacing between thumbnails.

Thumbnails Border

Specifies the border color, width and radius the thumbnails.
The default is '500' which makes the thumbnails round.

Thumbnails Position

- **Fixed**
Places the thumbnails at the bottom of the page at all times, even when the page scrolls.
- **Absolute**
The thumbnails will scroll with the content of the page.

Title

Specifies the style of the title. Uncheck 'show title' to hide the title.

z-index slides

Specifies the z-index of the slides.

This makes sure the slideshow is behind other content on the page.

z-index thumbnails

Specifies the z-index of the navigation.

This makes sure the slideshow is on top other content on the page.

Responsive Properties

The font size, thumbnail size, thumbnail spacing, thumbnail offset and padding are responsive, which means that these properties can have a different value in breakpoints.

Note that the slideshow is always full screen, so the size of the object on the workspace does not matter.

How to install this extension so it is available in WYSIWYG Web Builder?

You can use the Extension Manager (Menu->Tools->Extension Manager) to install this extension.

Alternatively, you can manually copy all files from the zip file to the Web Builder extensions folder. Usually this folder is in this location:

My Documents\WYSIWYG Web Builder\system\extensions\
