


Perspective Menu - Version 1.1

This extension is an experimental menu that uses CSS3 3d transforms to push the page away to display a menu. The menu can be activated by clicking/touching the 'hamburger' button.

Note: Internet Explorer has limited support for 3d transforms, so it may not work as intended on this (out-of-date) browser.



General

In this section, you can add/edit and remove menu buttons. Each menu item can have a title, and link.

Style

The extension has many options to control the appearance of the menu items, like font, border and colors.

Close menu on link click

Normally the menu will only close when you click on the 'page container' or go to another page.

When 'Close menu on link click' is enabled the menu will also close when you click on a link on the same page.

Menu Offset

This specifies the offset (in percentages) of the menu. The default is 25%.

Breakpoint

For smaller screens, it may not be desirable to have a 3d view of the page, because of the limited space. The breakpoint property specifies when the 3d view will be hidden, so only the menu will be displayed.

The default is 480, which means that the 3d view will be hidden for screen widths equal or smaller than 480 pixels.

3d transform

The 3d transform properties define the offset, angle and perspective of the 3d view of the page.

The **Perspective** property defines how many pixels the 3d view of the page is placed from the view.

To find out the optimal value you may need to experiment with different values. The default is 1200px.

Translate X defines the horizontal offset of the 3d view of the page. The default is 100%. Using a smaller value will move the menu more to the left.

Translate Z defines the 3d translation for the Z-axis of the 3d view of the page. The default is 1200px (the same value as the perspective).

Rotate defines the rotation for 3d view of the page. The default is 45 degrees.

How to install this extension so it is available in WYSIWYG Web Builder?

You can use the Extension Manager (Menu->Tools->Extension Manager) to install this extension.

Alternatively, you can manually copy all files from the zip file to the Web Builder extensions folder. Usually this folder is in this location:

My Documents\WYSIWYG Web Builder\system\extensions\

WYSIWYG Web Builder 12.1 or higher

WYSIWYG Web Builder 12.2 or higher to support responsive font-size.
