

Random Player

Random player is an HTML audio player with (expandable) playlist. Optionally, the songs can be loaded from a folder on the server. The user can enable 'random mode', which randomly selects the next track. The player has many styling options, including the ability to customize play, pause, stop and playlist icons.

Tracks

In this section you can add, edit or remove tracks. For each track, you can set the filename, artist and title of the song. The user can make the playlist visible by clicking the 'playlist' icon'

Get audio files and images from a folder on the server

Enable this option to load songs (mp3, wav, ogg) from a folder on the server. The cover art images (png, jpg or webp) should have the same name as the audio file:
Britney Spears – Toxic.mp3
Britney Spears – Toxic.png

When loading audio files from the server, the files should have the following filename format:

Artist - Title.mp3

Artist - Title.webp

A dash is used as a separator between the artist and song title.

Seekbar

By default, the seekbar has animated stripes. To disable the animation, use the same color for progress and stripes.

Playlist columns

The columns property specifies the number of columns of the playlist.

Responsive

The extension player is responsive by design. This means that you can use it in layout grid (flexible layout) or in fixed/absolute layout using breakpoints.

Styling

The player has many other styling options to customize the font, size, colors, padding, seekbar, info panel etc.

Icons

It's also possible to customize the icon for play, pause, stop and playlist. Most icon libraries that work with WWB's icon object, will also work with player.

Icons will also be published as SVG to reduce the output size.

Note: for performance reasons the workspace only renders a 'place holder' of the player. Use preview or publish to view the full player.

How to install this extension so it is available in WYSIWYG Web Builder?

You can use the Extension Manager (Menu->Tools->Extension Manager) to install this extension.

Alternatively, you can manually copy all files from the zip file to the Web Builder extensions folder. Usually this folder is in this location:

My Documents\WYSIWYG Web Builder\system\extensions\
