


Responsive Sidebar Menu - Version 1.1

The Responsive Sidebar Menu extension displays a column of small icons at the left side of the page. When you hover the mouse over the icons, then the multi-level menu will become fully visible.

On mobile devices, the menu will be available as 'hamburger' drop down menu. It is also possible to always display the full menu or use it a panel menu!



General Properties

Add, edit and remove menu items to the menu. Each item can have a title, link and Font Awesome icon. The 'active' property can be used to indicate the current page.

Note:

If the button only has 1 sub item then it will not show the sub levels. Instead the button will be used as link.

Style Properties

Font

Font is the font family of text, such as Arial and Times New Roman.

Style

Style of the font such as Bold, Italic or Regular.

Mode

Sets the appearance of the menu:

- **default**
Displays the full menu (icon + text).
- **slide from left**
Display the icons only. When the mouse hovers over an icon, the menu will expand to its full size.
The menu's position is fixed, which means that it does not scroll with the rest of the page content.
- **panel**
This mode works the same as 'slide from left'. But instead the menu will take up the full height of the page.

Note:

If you want to use the menu inside a layout grid when it needs to be set to 'default' mode, because in the otherwise the menu will be fixed and this conflicts with 'floating' mode of layout grid.

You can however add the menu to a (fixed or floating) page header.

Alignment

Specifies the text alignment when the menu is in mobile mode.

Spacing

Specifies the spacing between buttons.

Icon Offset

Specifies the offset of the Font Awesome icon from the text.

Full Width

Specifies whether the menu is full width when used inside a layout grid.

Title

Specifies the menu title when the menu is in mobile mode.

Breakpoint

Specifies the width where the menu will switch from desktop to mobile mode.

Icon position

Specifies the position of the 'hamburger icon'. Left or right.

Max-height

Specifies the maximum height of the drop down menu in mobile mode.

Arrow offset

Specifies the offset to the arrow from the text.

Styling

The menu supports 2 menu levels and each level can have its own colors/padding.

How to install this extension so it is available in WYSIWYG Web Builder?

You can use the Extension Manager (Menu->Tools->Extension Manager) to install this extension.

Alternatively, you can manually copy all files from the zip file to the Web Builder extensions folder. Usually this folder is in this location:
My Documents\WYSIWYG Web Builder\system\extensions\

WYSIWYG Web Builder 12.1 or higher

WYSIWYG Web Builder 12.2 or higher to support responsive font-size.
