

# Bottom Player Extension

This extension for WYSIWYG Web Builder implements a responsive HTML audio player that remains fixed at the bottom of the browser window. It includes cover art, track information, playback controls, a seekbar and a toggleable playlist. The player can be used in flexible and fixed layouts with breakpoint-specific sizing and extensive styling options.

## Tracks

The Tracks page defines the playlist and its playback order. Each track can use a local file or an absolute URL for both the audio source and cover image.

### **Filename**

Specifies the audio file. Enter a local filename or an absolute URL to an audio resource supported by the browser.

### **Image**

Specifies the cover artwork. Enter a local image filename or an absolute image URL. The cover is displayed as a square.

### **Title / Artist**

Sets the track title and artist name displayed below the title and alongside the playlist entry.

### **Add**

Adds a new track to the playlist.

### **Edit**

Edits the currently selected track.

### **Remove**

Removes the selected track from the playlist.

### **Remove All**

Removes every track from the playlist.

### **Move Up / Move Down**

Changes the selected track's position and therefore its playback order.

## Settings

The Settings page controls the player bar, playlist, seekbar, icons and shadow. Color buttons open the standard color picker; numeric values are entered in pixels unless stated otherwise.

### General

**Font name:** Selects the font family used for track information, times and playlist text.

**Font size:** Sets the base text size. This value can be overridden for individual breakpoints.

**Image size:** Sets the square width and height of the cover artwork. This value can be overridden for individual breakpoints.

**Alpha:** Sets the transparency of the player and playlist backgrounds from 0 (fully transparent) to 255 (fully opaque).

**Background:** Sets the background color of the fixed player bar.

**Padding:** Sets the vertical inner spacing of the player and the gap between major player elements. This value can be overridden for individual breakpoints.

**Border width:** Sets the thickness of the top player border and playlist border. Use 0 to hide the border.

**Border color:** Sets the color of the player and playlist borders independently from the background colors.

**Border radius:** Rounds the upper corners of the player and playlist panel.

### Seekbar

**Track:** Sets the color of the unplayed portion of the seekbar.

**Thumb:** Sets the normal color of the draggable seekbar thumb.

**Thumb - hover:** Sets the hover color of the thumb and the accent color of the played portion of the seekbar.

**Spacing:** Sets the thickness of the seekbar track.

### Track

**Text:** Sets the title, artist, time and playlist text color.

**Background:** Sets the background color of the expandable playlist panel.

**Padding horizontal:** Sets the left and right inset of the player bar and the horizontal padding of playlist entries. This value can be overridden for individual breakpoints.

**Padding vertical:** Sets the vertical padding of playlist entries and related control spacing. This value can be overridden for individual breakpoints.

### *Icons*

**Icon font:** Selects the icon library used to generate the playback controls.

**Icon color:** Sets the color of the playback controls and playlist menu icon.

**Icon size:** Sets the width and height of Previous, Play/Pause, Next and the playlist menu icon. This value can be overridden for individual breakpoints.

**Border radius:** Sets the corner radius of the cover artwork and interactive icon backgrounds.

**Play icon:** Selects the glyph displayed while playback is stopped or paused.

**Pause icon:** Selects the glyph displayed while audio is playing.

**Previous icon:** Selects the glyph used to play the previous playlist track.

**Next icon:** Selects the glyph used to play the next playlist track.

### *Box Shadow*

**Shadow:** Sets the shadow color used behind the player, playlist, cover and seekbar thumb.

**Alpha:** Sets the shadow opacity from 0 (invisible) to 255 (fully opaque).

**Offset x:** Moves the shadow horizontally. Positive values move it to the right; negative values move it to the left.

**Offset y:** Moves the shadow vertically. Positive values move it downward; negative values move it upward.

**Blur:** Sets the softness and spread of the shadow.

## Responsive properties

The player supports breakpoint-specific values for Font size, Padding, Track padding horizontal, Track padding vertical, Icon size and Image size. When a breakpoint is active, these values replace the default sizes so the player can remain balanced on tablets and phones. Colors, icon selections, border settings and shadow settings remain shared across breakpoints.

## How to install this extension so it is available in WYSIWYG Web Builder?

You can use the Extension Manager (Menu->Tools->Extension Manager) to install this extension.

Alternatively, you can manually copy all files from the zip file to the Web Builder extensions folder. Usually, this folder is in this location:  
My Documents\WYSIWYG Web Builder\system\extensions\

WYSIWYG Web Builder 18 or higher
