

Mini Player

This extension for WYSIWYG Web Builder implements a compact, responsive audio player with cover artwork, a blurred artwork background, track information, transport controls, progress and volume sliders, and a slide-up playlist. The player card remains smaller than its container and is centered within the available area.

Mini Player includes coordinated color presets for quick styling. The layout, cover dimensions, controls, playlist, sliders and shadow can also be refined through properties.

Tracks

The Tracks page defines the playlist and playback order. The first configured track is loaded when the player starts. Selecting a playlist item loads and plays that track.

- **Filename** Specifies the audio file. Use Browse to select a local audio file, or enter a path or URL supported by the browser.
- **Image** Specifies the cover image for the track. The image is used as the main cover artwork and as the blurred background behind the player card.
- **Title** Sets the track title displayed in the player and playlist.
- **Artist** Sets the artist name displayed below the title and in the playlist.

Add: Adds a new track to the playlist.

Edit: Edits the selected track. Double-clicking a track performs the same action.

Remove: Removes the selected track or tracks from the playlist.

Remove All: Removes every track from the playlist.

Move Up / Move Down: Changes the selected track's position and therefore its playback order.

Settings

The Settings page controls typography, theme colors, card geometry, artwork, sliders, playlist styling, controls and the box shadow.

General

Font name: Selects the font family used for the track information, time values and playlist text.

Font size: Sets the base type size. Available values range from 6 to 96 points.

Preset: Selects Custom, Midnight, Graphite, Light, Crimson, Glass, Ocean, Sakura, Apple or Vapor. A preset applies a coordinated palette to the player, playlist, text, controls and sliders.

Background: Sets the background color of the full extension container. This color also contributes to the gradient used by the information and control panel.

Border width: Sets the player card border width from 0 to 999 pixels. Set this to 0 for no visible border.

Border radius: Sets the corner radius of the player card and its shadow layer from 0 to 999 pixels.

Padding: Sets the internal spacing around the panel content and the minimum space between the card and its container. The supported range is 0 to 99 pixels.

Cover size: Sets the preferred width of the player card and cover region from 80 to 999 pixels. The card is automatically limited by the available container width and height.

Cover radius: Sets the corner radius of the cover artwork from 0 to 999 pixels. This is independent of the outer card radius.

Progress and Volume

Track: Sets the inactive color of the progress and volume slider tracks.

Active: Sets the slider thumb color and the highlighted artist and duration text.

Slider size: Sets the progress slider thumb size from 4 to 32 pixels. The generated slider track height is approximately half this value; the volume thumb is rendered slightly smaller.

Accent: Sets the secondary accent used by the panel gradient and slider hover or focus state.

Playlist

Text: Sets the playlist text color and the main title and current-time color.

Background: Sets the background color of the slide-up playlist panel.

Padding horizontal: Sets the left and right spacing inside each playlist item from 0 to 99 pixels.

Padding vertical: Sets the top and bottom spacing inside each playlist item from 0 to 99 pixels.

Controls

Color: Sets the transport, playlist and volume icon color. The same color is also used for the player card border.

Size: Sets the width and height of the control buttons from 16 to 160 pixels. The icon glyph is scaled proportionally inside each button.

Radius: Sets the control button corner radius from 0 to 999 pixels. Use a value at least half the control size for circular buttons.

Box Shadow

Shadow: Sets the color of the dedicated shadow layer behind the player card. Shadow styling is independent of the selected color preset.

Offset X: Moves the shadow horizontally from -255 to 255 pixels. Negative values move it left; positive values move it right.

Offset Y: Moves the shadow vertically from -255 to 255 pixels. Negative values move it upward; positive values move it downward.

Alpha: Sets shadow opacity from 0 to 255. A value of 0 hides the shadow completely; 255 is fully opaque before blur is applied.

Blur: Sets the shadow blur radius from 0 to 255 pixels. Larger values create a softer and wider shadow.

Theme presets and customization

Midnight uses deep near-black surfaces with cool blue highlights. Graphite uses neutral dark gray with a warm accent. Light provides a bright neutral presentation. Crimson combines dark surfaces with red highlights. Glass uses pale translucent-looking colors with teal accents. Ocean uses deep blue-green surfaces with cyan. Sakura uses a light pink palette. Apple uses a clean light neutral palette with system blue. Vapor combines deep violet surfaces with magenta and cyan accents.

Preset palettes control Background, Playlist Background, Playlist Text, Control Color, Track, Active and Accent. Selecting one of these properties manually immediately changes Preset to Custom, preserving the chosen color instead of allowing the previous preset to overwrite it when the dialog closes. The box shadow color and geometry remain independently configurable and do not change the preset.

Responsive layout and artwork

The extension fills the width and height of its WYSIWYG Web Builder container. The player card remains centered and uses the configured Cover size as its preferred width while shrinking when the container is smaller. The cover occupies the upper artwork area and the information and controls are arranged in the lower panel. On short containers, spacing and control gaps are reduced automatically.

Each track's image is duplicated in the published player: a sharp copy appears as the cover artwork and a blurred, enlarged copy fills the surrounding background. The design-time preview displays the configured cover size and centers the source image in the upper artwork region while preserving its original aspect ratio.

Playlist and playback behavior

The playlist button opens or closes a panel from the bottom of the card. Playlist rows show the configured cover, title and artist. Clicking a row loads it and starts playback. Previous and Next wrap around the playlist, and a completed track automatically advances to the next configured item from the beginning.

Play/Pause controls the current audio item. The progress slider seeks within the track and the displayed current time and duration are updated from browser audio metadata. The volume slider changes audio volume. Browser autoplay restrictions may require the visitor to press Play before audio can begin.

How to install this extension so it is available in WYSIWYG Web Builder?

You can use the Extension Manager (Menu->Tools->Extension Manager) to install

this extension.

Alternatively, you can manually copy all files from the zip file to the Web Builder extensions folder. Usually, this folder is in this location:
